Future Skills will bring together expertise from all sectors and leverage experience from partners across the country.



I've mentioned the FutureSkill Lab in past Aspectives newsletters and have reported on my meeting in Ottawa. I've also shared with you the discussion paper released by the federal government. The federal government is earnest in moving forward on this initiative as evidenced by its mention in both the 2017 and the 2018 federal budgets.

If you haven't already read the [discussion paper](#), please take a moment to do so.

At this morning's Canadian Coalition of Community Based Employability Trainers ([CCCBET](#)) we discussed developing a

coordinated pan-Canadian response to the discussion paper. I need your help to provide up-to-date feedback that will help inform our response. We will be addressing the questions raised in the document, but information at a community level is also needed:



EPBC RFQ Dropped

In case you missed it, the request for qualifications for the Employment Program of BC was posted through BC Bid on February 28. Although expected, the biggest response ASPECT has received has been about consolidation and redistribution of the catchments.

The challenge with the redistribution of catchments means that new partnerships and relationships will need to be formed amongst service providers. Also, there are concerns that "interlopers" without a connection to the community could undermine the fabric of existing community infrastructures.
